Dear Parent(s),

The fact that you have asked to have your child baptized is a sure sign that you recognize the importance of God in your life. Your child's baptism is a time for celebration and joy. And, naturally you want the best for your child. We hope to help you plan and prepare for the baptism in the best possible way. We kindly ask you to register in the parish if you haven't already to help facilitate smoothly the administration of the Sacraments. From Parents, we need the following:

__ Register in our parish community. Forms are available at the Parish Office.

__ Attend the Baptismal Preparation Class at Blessed Sacrament (first child only.) Please call the parish office at 630-897-1029 to register. If you have attended a previous class from another parish please request that the parish send a letter to Blessed Sacrament stating that you have previously attended a Baptism Preparation Class. Classes are held on the first Monday of the even months at 6:30 pm in the Religious Education Building.

__ Fill out the **Baptism Register Form** and return to parish office.

__ Parent must contact the parish office to schedule a date for the Sacrament of Baptism for their child. Baptisms are held on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month after the 10:30 am Mass.

From God Parent(s) we need:

__ A copy of a certificate/letter (or signed sponsor card with parish seal) stating you are currently in good standing from your Catholic parish.

Note: You may have only one godparent. If however, you have only one Godparent then the Godparent must be a practicing Catholic in good standing with the church. If you have two and only one is a practicing Catholic, then the second Godparent may be a Christian witness, which means a person of another faith. A proxy is allowed in the event that the Godparent is unable to be present on the day of the baptism. The church welcomes your child into its midst with love and prayers for the future peace and happiness of your family in the years ahead.
